ROTARY TREE PLANTATION

On July 26, 2025, the Rotary Club of Kathmandu, in collaboration with the Rotary Clubs of Patan, Bagmati, Balaju, and Yala, successfully planted 600 saplings using the Miyawaki technique at Sano Hattiban, Lalitpur. This method involves densely planting a diverse mix of native tree species in a small area to accelerate forest growth and enhance biodiversity. By simulating natural forest succession, the Miyawaki technique encourages rapid tree growth through competitive resource utilization.



This initiative was part of the broader Rotary Plantation Day 2025, during which over 150 Rotary clubs across Nepal collectively planted more than 50,000 saplings in a single day, aligning with the district's environmental sustainability goals.
